A MESSAGE FROM FR RUSLAN

Each year on the Sunday before Easter, Christians around the world celebrate and commemorate what is traditionally called Palm or Passion Sunday; when we recount the events leading up to the betrayal, crucifixion and death of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. Holy Week is the high point of the Liturgical Year, culminating in the celebration of the Lord's Resurrection next Sunday. The Liturgy of Palm Sunday begins with a re-enactment of Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. After hearing the Gospel recount this event, everyone processes into church carrying blessed palms or olive branches.

The joy and triumph will change to another focus as we move into church and begin to hear the readings about the Suffering Servant of God from the book of the Prophet Isaiah, then the great passage from Saint Paul's Letter to the Philippians about Christ and finally the recounting of the betrayal, passion, and death of the Lord according to the Gospel writer, this year Saint Mark. The blessed branches received and carried at the beginning of the celebration are reminders that we are committed to following Christ and being faithful to the Lord.

GIFT AID ENVELOPES

For several years, the number of parishioners actively using weekly Gift Aid envelopes for the offertory collection has been declining and the cost of purchasing the minimum number of envelope boxes outweighs the financial benefit the parish receives back in tax reclaimed from HMRC. Therefore from 6 April 2024, no new envelopes will be available. If your preference is to continue to donate through cash, please do so using the basket but the parish will not be able to reclaim the tax you have paid on that donation.

Alternatively, you may wish to switch to using a regular monthly standing order for your offertory donation by completing the form, which can be found in the porch, or by using online or telephone banking. If you have not joined the Gift Aid scheme, please complete a Gift Aid Declaration form that can also be found in the porch. This is a fantastic way of making your offertory donation go further, as the Parish can reclaim an additional 25% from HMRC. Last year this amounted to over £14,000 for all the offertory, second collections and appeals.

NEW BIKE RACKS

You may have seen the two new green bike racks at the left hand side of the church. These, and their installation, have been entirely funded by Elmbridge Borough Council from their Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) - it has not cost the parish a penny! The disabled parking place that was there has now been moved to the right-hand side of the car park, and is hopefully easier to use.

So if you feel like making a more healthy and sustainable journey to Mass, then get on your bike and don't forget to bring a lock and chain.
