BUCKET COLLECTION AND PETITIONS

GIFT AID ENVELOPES

For several years, the number of parishioners actively using weekly Gift Aid envelopes for the offertory collection has been declining and the cost of purchasing the minimum number of envelope boxes outweighs the financial benefit the parish receives back in tax reclaimed from HMRC. Therefore from 6 April 2024, no new envelopes will be available. If your preference is to continue to donate through cash, please do so using the basket but the parish will not be able to reclaim the tax you have paid on that donation.

Alternatively, you may wish to switch to using a regular monthly standing order for your offertory donation by completing the form, which can be found in the porch, or by using online or telephone banking. If you have not joined the Gift Aid scheme, please complete a Gift Aid Declaration form that can also be found in the porch. This is a fantastic way of making your offertory donation go further, as the Parish can reclaim an additional 25% from HMRC. Last year this amounted to over £14,000 for all the offertory, second collections and appeals

He can offer the Sacrments of Reconciliation, Communion and anointing of the sick or just say hello. Everyone is important to us in our parish.
