Colombia, Let the Children Live. I know that
the generosity of your welcome will be

important and often vital work.

Here's a reminder of the charity's origins
and work.

The charity was founded in 1992 by Fr Peter
Walters, who first became involved with the
street-children in 1982 when they helped him
after he became temporarily stranded in
Colombia. It is a charitable (not-for-profit)
organisation and does not engage in political
activity. "We recognise that the
phenomenon of the street-children is the
product of complex social problems to
which there are no easy answers. Our aim is
to support the Colombian people as they
