**WELCOME TO MASS** Readings and prayers are found in the Parish Missals for The Thirty Second Sunday in Ordinary Time.

Dear Parishioners, dear friends,

I always mark my Remembrance Sunday with a virtual visit to the Cenotaph. I love seeing the massed bands, the march past and the wreathe laying. The music is evocative too and as the choir of the chapels royal sing 'O God our help in ages past', I join in (without hymn book!) if I am alone.

Remembrance is part of memory and is deep and complex. It is set off by familiar scenes and faces, by ritual and even by the senses. Remembrance takes us back, even to a time we have not directly experienced, almost as if we ourselves were there.

The Church uses a very specific idea to speak of the remembrance of Jesus Christ in the celebration of the Mass. The concept is known as anamnesis, a Greek word which appears in the gospels on the lips of Our Lord, 'Do this in memory of me'. It is important to understand that this idea of remembrance is not a dry and dusty remembrance and retelling of history; it is a dynamic idea, supernaturally bringing the events of the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ into our present.

Christians have misunderstood this notion of *dynamic* remembrance. The beautiful mystery of the Mass was downgraded by the protestant reformers because the quest for the historical Jesus seemed more important than belief in Him as Son of God and Saviour.

When we make remembrance of Jesus Christ we are empowered, through the sacramental guarantees of Holy Church, to bring all the merits and advantage, all the power and presence of God's mightiest work into the here and now. This is why the Mass is so powerful for us its power is palpable and its effectiveness of eternal significance - that is to say the celebration of the sacrifice of the Mass makes a difference to our eternal destiny. There are too many, even in our own Church, who think of the Mass as a nice little bit of nostalgia, a fellowship meal in which the Sacred Host is no more than a token. When we understand the power of the remembrance of Jesus Christ, His sacrifice and His Real presence, everything changes for us.

So we offer the Mass for our dead and for the fallen in war for our needs and the needs of those who suffer and for our own eternal salvation. Lord come and save us, Lord come to our aid. Lord heal the wounds of sin and division, Lord be our refuge and our guide. Every affectionate good wish *Fr Richard*
