- To revisit the Early Learning Goals from Reception.

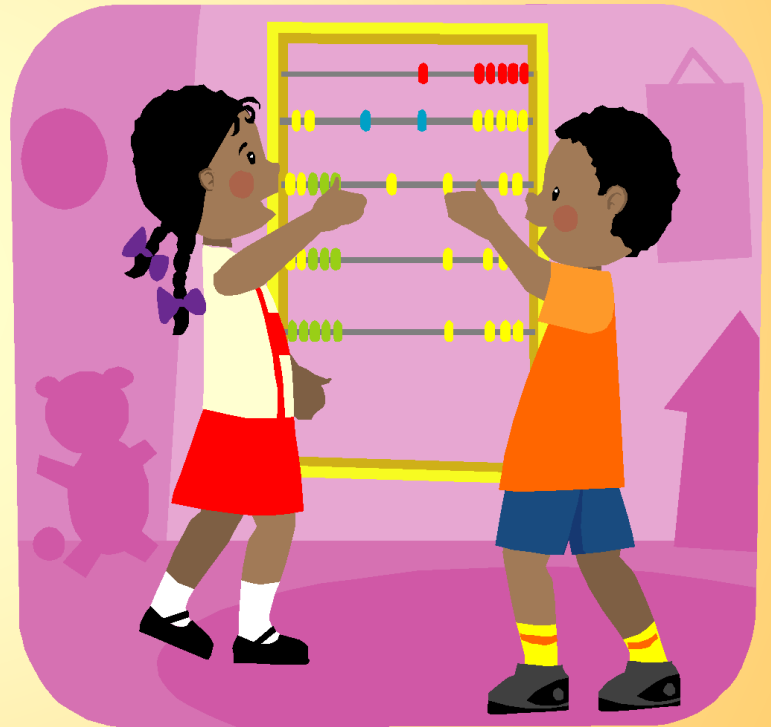
Curriculum Map and Timetable

Maths

- Areas covered – Numbers from 1-100
Addition to 20
Subtraction to 20
Multiplication & Division
Measurements
Fractions
Geometry
- Use of resources.
- Strategies taught – Mastery (White Rose)

Writing



- To write with spaces between words.
- To start a new sentence with a capital letter.
- To finish with a full stop.
- To write simple sentences using phonics and spelling rules.
- To provide opportunities for writing.

Reading



- It takes place throughout the day in many different forms
- **Please** spend 5-10 minutes every day listening to your child read and discussing the book and write a comment.
- Indicate with an '**F**' if you feel your child is ready to change their book and write a comment. Please make sure they read the book more than once to secure their understanding
- Your child will be heard read in class by an adult as often as possible.

Phonics

- End of Year 1 Phonics check.
- Daily Phonics lessons.
- Children will bring home their weekly phonics to continue to practise at home later in the year.

Early Intervention Support

- Mrs Evans Senco and Mrs Callari LSA work very closely with Year 1 .
- Ranges from literacy, speech and language to social skills, number formation & motor skills etc.
- Some children participate in just a few sessions, while others may run for much longer.
- We have been running the early intervention in Y1 for several years and it's been very successful.
- If you have any concerns about your child please speak to the class teacher or contact Mrs Evans via the school office.

Expectations of Year 1 children

- Wear uniform correctly, please ensure it is clearly labelled (even shoes!).
- Sew a tie or large hook into your child's coat, jumper and painting apron.
- All children need a coat in school every day, as we will go outside if wet.
- To become more independent in the classroom and around school, including in the dinner hall.

PE kit

- This should be in school every day
(Earrings must not be worn on P.E. days)
- Please ensure your children have both plimsolls and outdoor shoes.

Green Class - Wednesday pm & Friday pm

Yellow Class - Thursday pm & Friday pm

The Wednesday/Thursday slots are not fixed.

PE kit will be sent home at the end of each half term to be washed and check plimsolls still fit.

Snacks

- Please only send fruit and vegetables for morning snack.
- Please label your child's snack clearly.
- Please ensure your child has a named water bottle with water, not juice, in school every day.

Other essentials

- Colouring Book - Please provide your child with a thin colouring book to use at wet play.
- Tissues - please provide a box of tissues to share with the class.
- Cooking money - we would be grateful for a contribution of £5. - cooking ingredients, seeds, Bulbs, etc.
