- All children will travel on their own individual passport.

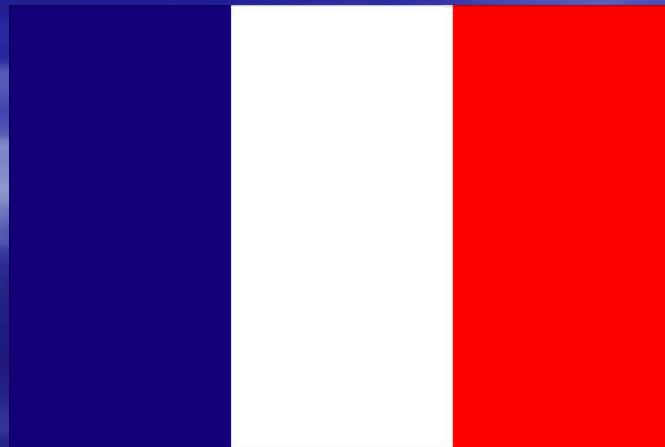
# OTHER ACTIVITIES

# Cost

- The cost of the trip this year will be £425 and this includes all travel, accommodation, educational visits, insurance, a leaver's hoodie and food.
